

Educational Curriculum

The course will commence in two phases.

- Phase I: During this phase, our primary goal is to provide a solid foundation in core subjects such as history, polity, geography, economy, and environment. This phase will ensure coverage of NCERTs and standard textbooks. The outcome of this phase is strong foundation in the subjects, conceptual clarity and sense of confidence among the students. Students will be tested continuously in multiple choice questions based tests on the pattern of CSE Prelims exam. The goal of Phase I is to ensure success in the Prelims exam, regardless of the difficulty level.
 - **Note:** Serves two key purposes: first, it helps students mentally and physically prepare for the more in-depth Phase 2, which focuses on the Mains exam. Phase I will also help students in targeting other government jobs like BPSC, BSSC and other State PSC exams which are also objective MCQ-based exams. This will also help in boosting confidence in the students. This phase is content and practice-driven, and aims to provide students with the knowledge and skills they need to succeed in these exams.
- Phase 2: This phase ensures pinpointed coverage of Mains syllabus and saves your time from doing unnecessary research. You need to simply focus on understanding, revision and answer writing in Phase 2. There will be in-depth coverage of the syllabus for the General Studies Mains exam, including dedicated answer writing sessions, assignments, and subjective tests. Students will receive high-quality class notes and study materials covering more than 200 topics, including current affairs. This will provide students with the necessary tools to confidently tackle any question in the CSE Mains exam.

How ForumIAS is going to be different this time?

Components of Foundation @ ForumIAS

Comprehensive Preparation In Dedicated Timeline

The foundation program helps students do the right thing at the right time. LEARNING COMPONENTS

- GS Classes The classes take care of complete preparation for Prelims and Mains. The classes are conducted in offline and online mode. They are followed up with doubt sessions. These classes are supplemented with crisp handouts making revision an easier task. The classes shall be conducted 6 day a week from Monday to Saturdays.
- CSAT Classes We offer a helpful strategy and method for the aptitude test called CSAT. The class will include materials and practice questions. We will also talk about questions from previous years to help you stay up to date with the most recent trends for the exam. Our team of experts in English and mental ability will help you prepare for the CSAT paper more quickly by giving you a clear understanding of the concepts and helping you practice regularly.
- Current Affairs Classes In our Current Affairs classes, we cover entire dynamic portion of Mains as well as Prelims examination, with crisp notes, one-pager handouts for a chaos free preparation, like no other. EVALUATIONS & REVISION

- Daily Benchmark Assignments (BAs) The first step of evaluation & revision components is daily benchmark assignments. - Benchmarks Tests (BTs) The second step of evaluation & revision components is benchmark test. The benchmark test will comprise objective tests in the Phase I and subjective tests in Phase 2. These are conducted at regular intervals to simulate UPSC examination pattern from the very beginning of the preparation journey. The Benchmarks Tests (BTs) are designed to help students in monthly revision. These tests are important as a student is not expected to learn the trick and trade of solving MCQs or Answer Writing on day one, but it is a gradual process, and these tests will help you incrementally learn the same.
- Select Focus Group (SFG) The third step of evaluation & revision components is SFG. The SFG begins post your completion of GS Classes. It consists of 50 Questions / I hour test written every day (except Sunday) in disciplined manner at a designated time. With multiple tests for each subject, it ensures you have completed a detailed revision of all the recommended textbooks for Prelims.
- Answer Writing Focus Group (AWFG) The fourth step of evaluation & revision components is AWFG Test. Generally held post prelims, this is SFG for Mains. It ensures detailed revision. The tests are followed up with detailed discussion which will help you understand how to approach a question as well as create niche content for the questions and topics asked in tests. Discipline is again an important part of this program.

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Mains Guidance Program (MGP) - The fifth step of evaluation & revision components is MGP Test. The Mains Guidance Program (MGP) is a mentor guided, test series-based preparation Program for Civil Services Mains Preparation.

SUPPORT COMPONENTS

- Dedicated Teaching Assistant (TA) ATA will be present in every class as a friend to engage with students and help them clear their doubts. TA will be acting as a link between students and the faculty.
- Mentorship Available in person, online and telephonic mode, mentors will partner with you to diagnose where you are going wrong and help you improve your content and skills required for exam.
