Many parts of the syllabus like Indian polity, International Relations, parts of World history etc. are studied by candidates for General studies regardless of their choice of optional. In PSIR optional the candidates prepare these topics in wholesale manner for both General studies and optional paper.
- Due to very wide area of coverage the knowledge of PSIR optional is immensely useful in Essay paper and Interview.
- In the revised syllabus of PSIR optional purely theoretical, academic and factual topics have been removed and thus it can be prepared easily even by those who do not have background in this subject.
