

Corrigendum/Explanation PTS 2024 Simulator CSAT Test 2

There are 6 updates in the paper (Q.11,14, 24, 35, 63 and Q.71)

- In Q.11, there is no matching option, so all the students need to be awarded 2.5 marks.
- In Q.14, there is no matching option, so all the students need to be awarded 2.5 marks.
- In Q.24, both Options a and d are correct.
- In Q.35 for Hindi Medium Students, there was a misprinting in the question, so all the students from Hindi medium need to be awarded 2.5 marks.
- In Q.63, there is no matching option, so all the students need to be awarded 2.5 marks.
- In Q.71, there is no matching option, so all the students need to be awarded 2.5 marks.

In Q.11) There was a doubt raised with respect to Option c i.e “Cultural diversity enhances creativity and innovation within societies” whether reflected the essence of the passage.

Exp) It is an incorrect option. There was no matching answer of the passage.

Passage -I

Throughout history, culture and festivities have been vital components of human societies, weaving intricate tapestries of tradition, identity, and community cohesion. Through shared rituals, values, and symbols, societies cultivate collective consciousness, preserving heritage and shaping social norms.

Q.11) Which of the following statements reflects the essence of the passage?

- a) Cultural practices often influence dietary habits and culinary traditions within societies.
- b) Festivities contribute to the promotion of physical health and well-being among community members.
- c) Cultural diversity acts as binding agent in a society.
- d) The decline of traditional customs can lead to increased environmental sustainability.

Ans) c

Exp) Option c is the correct answer.

Option a is incorrect. While cultural practices indeed influence dietary habits, this aspect is not the primary focus of the passage, which emphasizes social cohesion and identity formation.

Option b is incorrect. Although festivities may contribute to physical health indirectly through community bonding, this aspect is not the central theme of the passage.

Option c is correct. It aligns with the passage's emphasis on the positive impacts of cultural diversity on societies cohesiveness through social connections.

Option d is incorrect. While the decline of traditional customs may have implications for environmental sustainability, it is not the main point discussed in the passage, which primarily focuses on social and cultural aspects.

In Q.14) a doubt was raised with respect to statements 2 and 4 of the passage.

Exp) Option a is the correct answer

- **statement 1 is correct.** The passage suggests that globalization has influenced traditional practices, potentially leading to a blending of traditional and modern cultural elements.
- **statement 2 is correct,** as it acknowledges the possibility of cultural preservation in some rural communities without implying complete preservation.
- **statement 3 is incorrect.** The passage indicates that globalization has led to the erosion rather than preservation of indigenous cultural practices.

- **statement 4 is incorrect.** The passage does not suggest complete loss of cultural identity in rural India.

In Q.16) 2 options were same i.e Option a and Option d

Exp) Option b is the correct answer

Applying the given transformation to the word "CONSERVE" using the reversed alphabet mapping, we get:

C -> X O -> L N -> M S -> H E -> V R -> I V -> E E -> V

So, the word "CONSERVE" becomes "XLMHVIEV" in the reversed alphabet scheme.

Ans) a

Exp) Option a is the correct answer.

Any digits cannot have either a bigger or smaller number on both the adjacent places means digits can only either increase or decrease.

This means for each combination of 3 digits only two passwords are possible. Number of ways of selection of 3 digits out of 9 = ${}^9C_3 = 84$

Now for each set as 2 ways possible

So total number of ways = $84 \times 2 = 168$

In Q.63) a doubt was raised with respect to Option a of the passage which talks about what characterizes demographic transition.

Exp) There is no matching answers to the passage.

Exp) option a is the correct answer

Option a is correct. The passage highlights that in the early stages of demographic transitions, declining death rates lead to population growth and a youthful demographic structure.

Option b is incorrect. The passage indicates that demographic transitions present both opportunities and challenges for economic growth and social welfare.

Option c is incorrect. The passage discusses how declining birth rates in later stages of demographic transitions lead to an aging population and potential labor shortages.

Option d is incorrect. The passage emphasizes the importance of comprehensive policies and governance to manage the impacts of demographic transitions effectively, but it does not assert that they are the sole characteristic of demographic transitions.

In Q.71) a doubt was raised with respect to Option c of the passage which talks about consequence of India's politicization of crime

Exp) There is no matching answers to the passage.

Passage –I

India's politicization of crime has led to the criminalization of politics, a troubling phenomenon with far-reaching implications for governance, democracy, and societal well-being. Exp) option c is the correct answer.

Option a is incorrect. While increased public awareness and activism against corruption may be positive outcomes, the passage focuses on the negative consequences of India's politicization of crime.

Option b is incorrect. The passage discusses how the criminalization of politics has weakened democratic norms and institutions, rather than strengthening political parties and governance structures.

Option c is correct. The passage highlights that politicians with criminal backgrounds often exploit their positions for personal gain and perpetuate corruption, which is a consequence of India's politicization of crime and it is a serious challenge to rule of law.

Option d is incorrect. The passage emphasizes the erosion of transparency and accountability in political processes due to the politicization of crime, rather than fostering an environment of transparency and accountability.
