PLEASE NOTE

- #Caution Fee is a fully refundable fee to be deposited at the time of joining the campus. Caution fee in part may be forfeited to recover the losses due to any loss or damage to property. It may be used to provide aid in case of a medical emergency.
- Seat Reserve Charges are payable one time and are non-refundable under any circumstance. Students are expected to understand that for every room that is left unoccupied because the candidate decided to drop out will lead to us incurring the cost of the rent of the room for the next 4.5 months. This has happened before and has financially wrecked the program. However, against the on time non-refundable seat reserve charges, students will be sent by post relevant study material for prelims and Red books. Note that this is a mandatory fee and cannot be adjusted under any circumstance, not even on grounds that the student has part of full of the study material.
- Seats are limited and no refunds are possible after course commencement in tuition fees once paid. However, there is a fair withdrawal opportunity given to each student. Go through the acceptance note document.
- SFG Level 2 is included in FRC 5. However, all students must appear for the entrance test of SFG Level 2 by paying the entrance test fee. No students will be allowed in SFG Level 2 without having cleared the SFG level 2 entrance test. However, it will be expected that the student is able to compete
