"Prelims is changing, so are we."

Charles Darwin famously said – "Not the strongest, nor the most intelligent, but one who adapts to change will survive."

With the changing pattern of questions asked in Civil Services Prelims and oscillation between different patterns and difficulty level, merely reading basic books, solving papers at home may not suffice.

At least not for those for whom Prelims is new or for those who have been unable to crack it.

What is ForumIAS Prelims Rapid Revision Classes (PRRC)?

SFG *Level* **1**: Students will get access to SFG Level 1 commencing from 1st week of December; However, they need to pay the registration fees and take the entrance exam.



All India Prelims Simulator Test Series: Students will get access to one of the most relevant & covered test series for Prelims i.e. ForumIAS all India Simulators. This will comprise 8 GS full length + 6 CSAT full length alongside too All India mock examination.

The offline and live classes will start from 5 PM. The classes will be conducted 6 days a week. The recorded lectures will be available post 36 hours from the end time of the live class.

Why is Prelims exam a challenge for many students?

Prelims as the Biggest Hurdle: For many of you, prelims is the biggest obstacle in clearing the Civil Services Exam, and it's a stage where many students get stuck. Our experience also demonstrates that our own students – Ishita, Pranita, Minal, Kajal, and Aprajita – who are now IAS officers, achieved success by **clearing the Prelims and converting their first mains attempt into a success story**.

Apart from these several students cleared the exam after clearing Prelims in their 5/6th attempt

Time Allocation: Amid the focus on Mains and answer writing, students often end up devoting less time to prelims preparation.

Conceptual Clarity: Some students struggle with conceptual clarity in certain subjects, which may not be apparent during Mains preparation but become problematic during the Prelims exam.

Balancing Static and Current Affairs: Finding the right balance between the static portion and current affairs for prelims can be challenging, resulting in significant weaknesses in either or both areas for some students.

Comfort Zone and Dynamism: Many students find it difficult to transition from the comfort zone of Mains preparation to the dynamic nature required for prelims. This can impact their consistency and confidence.
