What is the problem we are trying to solve?

The nature of Prelims examination has been ever evolving. This requires not just a reading of the basic text, but also understanding of advanced concepts, coverage of new areas from which questions are asked. People who clear Prelims are not just the ones who have done static and current well. It is also not those who only *know* how to solve the prelims questions - because a strategy that works one year does not work the other year.

What is Prelims Sprint?

Prelims Sprint aims to solve this problem by providing a short duration course targeted for Prelims 2025 with a fair mix of classes, regular tests and mentorship that aims to help students writing the Prelims examination have a robust preparation before they attempt the Prelims on May 25th.

What does the Program contain?

The program contains the below

- 1. **Content building classes :** These classes will be held 4 days a week in the Offline and online mode only from 4PM to 6PM and 6:30 to 8:30 PM.
- 2. **Learning Outcome Tests (LOTS)**: After the topics are covered, there will be revision and learning outcomes tests on the subsequent day from 8PM.
- 3. **SFG Level 2**: Candidates will be writing SFG Level 2 once the course is over. However candidates will be required to register for and clear the entrance for the same. Fees for SFG Level 2 are included in PRRC.

Who should join this program?

This program is suitable for candidates who have tried their hand at prelims, and have not found success - simply because despite the hard work, they have failed to understand the core demand of the examination. It should be taken by candidates who are willing to commit 20 hours / week for test taking and classes for securing prelims 2025.

Working candidates with paucity of time can take this program as a one stop solution for prelims and bank on it for their preparation.

Candidates who have gotten started with the basic books can also take advantage of the program for accelerated learning, and speeding up their preparation.

Mode of the class : The class will be provided in recorded format only.

Duration: 2.5 - 3 Months approximately

Class Days: Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday



What if I miss a class?

Since the classes will be provided in recorded format, so, all the classes will be available on the Portal till 30th May 2025.

Further tests have to be written at the designated time in LIVE mode only. Tests cannot be written at any time as per one's will - which defeats the purpose of the program. It is this discipline that is crucial for selection in the prelims.
