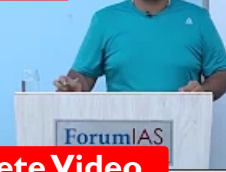

Detailed Syllabus

GS - I

- Modern History of India and Indian Culture.
- Current events of national and international importance.
- Statistical Analysis, Drawing and Illustration.

This paper will include an outline of the history of the country from the middle of the nineteenth century onwards under the History of Modern India (with special reference to Bihar) and Indian Culture, as well as questions related to Gandhi, Rabindranath Tagore and Nehru. Questions in the context of the modern history of Bihar will be asked from the beginning and development of Western education (including technical education) in this region. It will have questions related to the role of Bihar in the Indian freedom struggle. These questions will mainly be asked from the Santhal Rebellion, 1857 in Bihar, Birsa's Movement, Champaran Satyagraha and the Quit India Movement of 1942. Candidates are expected to be familiar with the art of the Maurya and Pala periods and the main features of Patna Kalam Painting.

In topics related to statistical analysis, graphs and pictorial representations, the ability to use common sense to draw conclusions based on knowledge of statistical graphs or pictorial representations and to point out the shortcomings, limitations and inconsistencies found in them.

GS - II

- Indian Polity.
- Indian Economy and Geography of India.
- Role and impact of science and technology in the development of India.

In this question paper, the section related to Indian Polity will contain questions related to the political system of India (and Bihar). In the section related to Indian Economy and Geography of India and Bihar, questions related to Indian Planning and Physical, Economic and Social Geography of India will be asked.

Related to the role and impact of science and technology in the development of India, in the third section, such questions will be asked which will test the knowledge of the candidate about the importance of science and technology in India and Bihar. Emphasis will be given on the practical aspect in these.
