



Atlantic migration route

Context : In 2024 alone : more than 10,000 migrants lost their lives on Atlantic migration route.

4 things you should know:

- 1. **AMR =** Dangerous route that migrants take from West Africa to the Canary Islands (Spain)
- 2. Canary Islands! Atlantic Ocean + Approx. 62 miles west of Morocco (Africa) + European Union's outermost regions.
- 3. Departure points: Senegal, The Gambia, Mauritania, Morocco, Guinea.
- 4. Causes: Conflict in the Sahel region, unemployment, climate change, stricter border controls in the Mediterranean

- 3. Present status: 11 States | First: Assam, J&K, Nagaland | LatestTelangana.
- 4. Benefits: tax concessions + Special Plan Assistance + Central assistance 90%.
