The number of students has been kept limited to enable better interaction and mentorship during the prelims to Mains period.

Strategy & Philosophy behind the Program

The key to cracking Civil Services with a Top Rank goes through GS Paper IV. And the way to score well in the GS IV has two key pillars - Have great content and Practice answer writing well. The Ethics Answer Writing Program consists of a total of 8 Tests so that candidates can hone the ability to think on their feet and practice answer writing skills. The program consists of 6 half-length tests - with live & online video discussions so that the handholding necessary for answer writing is done in a focused manner. In these LIVE sessions, candidates will be provided not only the content for the answer, but the focus will be on how to think and solve the questions and the value addition that can be done. The discussion videos will be available on the student dashboard till the end of Mains 2025 examination.

Subsequently, the candidates are expected to write 2 Full Length Tests with Detailed Solutions and evaluation so that they have adequate practice for their mains before attempting the actual paper. These tests along with MGP tests on GS IV will complete the much-needed practice that is crucial to getting a good rank and service. 1:1 discussion with mentors will help further make improvements that have helped hundreds of students benefit from GS IV courses by ForumIAS.

Deliverables of the Program

1. 6 Half Length Tests with LIVE Answer Writing discussions along with evaluation
2. 2 Full Length Tests with Detailed Solutions & Evaluation
3. Mentorship with dedicated Cohort Mentor for answer writing

Pre-requisite for the course

While answer writing will be taught from scratch in the course, candidates are expected to have basic reading of GS IV. This can be done by attending Ethics+ classes (available in online / offline mode) or finishing off the theoretical base through the Ethics Red Book.
