Why Essay Paper in CSE is a challenge?


Essay paper has become the determinant factor for getting selection as well as top ranks in CSE with high variation of upto 45-50 marks for an individual student in consecutive Mains. At the same time, there were students securing high score of 140+ to as low as 37 in UPSC CSE for several years.

It has always been considered to be a paper with good scoring potential with much lesser effort needed as compared to GS. However, UPSC has changed this narrative. Essay paper is emerging as one of the most challenging papers for students, requiring their consistent effort and attention now.

There is no holy grail strategy for essay and hence there could be numerable ways of approaching a single essay topic. Apart from knowing the content and being able to present in a coherent structure, essay paper is all about MINDSET. This makes practice writing an essay very important.

How will EGP 2026 help me in Essay Paper?

We believe that the program through its classes, workshops, tests and discussions will assist the student in a) better understanding of the complexities and core demand of the topic, b) build reusable content including value added content and expand your available knowledge base, and c) practice and evaluate your essay writing skills

What are the features of the program?				
Workshops:	Multiple interactive workshops will be conducted to equip you with various strategies and techniques for essay writing. These workshops will assist you in brainstorming, understanding essay requirements, and organizing your content effectively.			
Thematic Classes:	The content classes will cover both GS and philosophical themes to give the student adequate content to write a good essay. The objective is to train students to use the available content in their essays and not burden with excessive content.			
Mentorship Support:	A team of dedicated mentors will provide individual mentorship based on the essay test, both in offline and online mode. As every student has a different understanding and approach on a topic, a mentor can guide the student to highlight shortcomings and bridge the gap of their understanding and the expectation. Test Copy Evaluation:	The essay evaluation unlike GS evaluation is not done on set parameters. Instead, the focus is on multi- dimensional analysis and trying to appreciate different viewpoints on the topic. An experienced team of evaluators will provide comprehensive, objective and timely evaluation of Sectional test and Full-length test copy within 5 days from the date of submission.			
Material and Resources:	The handouts (answer skeleton) on essay topics will be provided with every test and will consist of adequate content in usable format with value addition points like examples, anecdotal references and quotes.
