What is the problem we are trying to solve?

The nature of Prelims examination has been ever evolving. This requires not just a reading of the basic text, but also understanding of advanced concepts, coverage of new areas from which questions are asked. What is Prelims Sprint?

Prelims Sprint aims to solve this problem by providing a short duration course targeted for Prelims 2026 with a fair mix of classes, regular tests and mentorship that aims to help students writing the Prelims examination have a robust preparation before they attempt the Prelims on May 24th.

What does the Program contain?

The program contains the below

1. **Content building classes:** These classes will be held 5 days a week in the Offline and online mode only from 4 PM to 6 PM and 6:30 PM to 8:30 PM.
2. **Learning Outcome Tests (LOTS):** After the topics are covered, there will be revision and learning outcomes tests on the subsequent day from 9PM.
3. **SFG Level 2:** Candidates will be writing SFG Level 2 once the course is over. However, candidates will be required to register for and clear the entrance for the same. Fees for SFG Level 2 are included in Prelims Sprint.
4. **Full Length Simulators:** Once the course gets over, candidates will be required to write ForumIAS Simulator Tests - Series of 10 Full Length GS Tests + 9 Full Length CSAT Tests for the final sharpening of the axe.
5. **PYQ Analysis:** Program included PYQs of Prelims - the gold standard for PYQ classes by ForumIAS.
6. **Current Affairs Classes for Prelims 2026:** Program contains Prelims Current Affairs Classes - series of 18-20 classes to be held in February - March exclusively for Prelims 2026.

Who should join this program?

This program is suitable for candidates who have tried their hand at prelims and have not found success - simply because despite the hard work, they have failed to understand the core demand of the examination. It should be taken by candidates who are willing to commit 25 hours / week for test taking and classes for securing prelims 2026.

Mode of the class: The class will be conducted in OFFLINE and LIVE online mode only.

What if I miss a class?

This is a fast paced course with the purpose of training candidates to clear prelims in one go. If you miss a class in the LIVE mode, you can still watch and finish the classes till before the next test or 48 hours - whichever is earlier. Do not join the class, if you have any other priorities apart from prelims during this period. Further tests must be written at the designated time in LIVE mode only. Tests cannot be written at any time as per one's will - which defeats the purpose of the program. It is this discipline that is crucial for selection in the prelims.
