Current Affairs Classes are designed to help aspirants prepare dynamically, not mechanically. Instead of daily information overload, preparation is organised through **theme-wise classes** that reflect how UPSC actually frames questions.

Each theme is curated using the **Relevance, Recall, and Retention philosophy**—filtering news through exam value, linking it with static syllabus, and reinforcing it through repeated conceptual anchoring.

Classes focus on issue-based **understanding, interlinkages, and PYQ orientation** rather than headline memorisation. This ensures deeper comprehension and sharper application in both Prelims and Mains.

By structuring current affairs around themes, these classes transform scattered news into coherent, recall-friendly knowledge—helping aspirants prepare **current affairs like no other**.

ForumIAS conducts Year Long Current Affairs (Dynamic Issues – GS Paper 2 & 3 & Certain parts of GS 1 & 4) in 3 phases.

In the first phase, one of the challenges with other Current Affairs Classes is that Prelims is completely ignored in phase 1 and is left for last moment. However, we cover the pre-cum-mains syllabus of GS Papers through issue-based classes. Current Affairs for Prelims will be regularly covered alongside mains. Classes are held twice a week till the last week of January.
